Today, we are going to learn the letter Y. – Anpétu kiŋ lé “ya” unspéuŋkič’íchiyapi kte.

Y – “ya”

Y makes a _____ sound – “ya” léchel eyápi: yyyya

Can you say Y? – “ya” ehá oyákihi he?

Y – “ya”

Y is the first letter in the word “confused” – “ya” uŋ “yuhélhel úŋ” uŋkówapi uŋkókihipi.

And “three” or “tired” – Na “yámni” naiŋš “yuǵó”.
