

## Oówa Kiŋ He Khilí Yeló - H

Today, we are going to learn the letter H. – Anpétu kiŋ lé, "ha" uŋspéuŋkič'ičhiyapi kte.

H – "ha"

H makes a \_\_\_\_\_ sound – "ha" léčhel eyápi: hhhhha

Can you say H? – "ha" ehá oyákihi he?

H – "hhhhha"

H is the first letter in the word "bone" – "ha" uŋ "hohú" uŋkówapi uŋkókihipi

And "shoes" or "moose" – Na "háŋpa" naiŋš "hebláska"

Also "moon" – Na nakúŋ "haŋhépi wí"

Sometimes I like to go outside at "night" and see the moon. – Watóhaŋl šna haŋhépi háŋl ináwaphiŋ na haŋhépi wí kiŋ ablúta.

If I'm lucky I might see some "elk" too. – Wámaphi háŋtaŋš nakúŋ heháka etáŋ waŋwíčhablakiŋ kte séče.

Or maybe I will hear an "owl" hoot – Naiŋš uŋgnáš hiŋháŋ waŋží hotžúŋ nawáħ'uŋ kte.

Owls make spooky "noises" – Hiŋháŋ kiŋhaŋ wókħokpħeya šna hotžúŋpi.

I'm going outside! – Waná tħaŋkál blé!

H – "ha"

What a cool letter. – Oówa kiŋ he khilí yeló.
