Today, we are going to learn the letter T'. – **Aŋpétu kiŋ lé “t'o” uŋspéuŋkič'íčhiyapi kte.**

T' – “t'o”

T' makes a _____ sound – “t'o” léchel eyápi: t'o

Can you say T'? – “t'o” ehá oyákihi he?

T' – “t'o”

T' is the first letter in a lot of action words. – “t'o” uŋ wóškaŋ óta eyápi na owápi.

Like “to scream” – “t'ehówaya” eyápi kiŋ hé

And “to be frantic” – Na “t'ebléze šni” eyápi

And “to grunt” – Naháj “t'íŋğa” eyápi kiŋ hé

Also “to suspect something” – Na nakúŋ “t'uŋgyá”

I once “suspected” that our dog was digging holes in the backyard. – **Toháŋtuka waŋ šúŋka mit'háwa kiŋ thilázata mak'hák'a-haŋ čha “t'uŋgwáye”.**
