

Oówa kiŋ Hé Khilí Yeló! - Č

Today, we are going to learn the letter Č. – Anpétu kiŋ lé, "ču" unspéuŋkič'ičhiyapi kte.

Č – "ču"

Č makes a _____ sound – "ču" léčhel eyápi: *ču*

Can you say Č? – "ču" ehá oyákíhi he?

Č – "ču"

Č is the first letter in the word "monster" and "little monster" – "ču" uŋ čičí na čičí čík'ala unkwówapi unkwókihipi.

You know what? There aren't a lot of words that start with Č. – Táku ochíciyakiŋ kte: "ču" uŋ wičhóiyé líla óta owápi šni.

But you can find Č in the middle of words, too. – Hó éyaš wičhóiyé óta él, "ču" waŋží yaŋké.

Like "chief" – Načá eyápi kiŋ hé él, "ču" waŋ yaŋké.

Or "grandmother" – Na uŋčí eyápi kiŋ hé él.

Also "Drumstick. – Na nakúŋ ičábu.

Once I couldn't find my drumstick. – Tóhaŋ ičábu kiŋ wagnúni.

I tried using a "broom" instead. – Čha éeye wičahiŋte waŋ múŋ.

That didn't work so well. – Líla hčičiŋ wíyokihi šni.

Maybe if I had a really, really big drum! – Ešá čháŋčeĝa waŋží líla tháŋka čha bluhá šni!

Č – "ču"

What a cool letter. – Oówa kiŋ hé khilí yeló.
