

Oówa Kiŋ He Khilí Yeló - M

Today, we are going to learn m. – **Aŋpétu kiŋ lé, "ma" uŋspéuŋkič'ičhiyapi kte.**

m makes a m sound – **"ma" léčhel eyápi: mmm**

Can you say m? – **"ma" ehá oyákihi he?**

m – **"mmm"**

What can we spell with m? – **"ma" uŋ takúku uŋkówapi uŋkókihipi sé!**

We use m to spell “goose”. – **"ma" uŋ "maǵá" uŋkówapi uŋkókihipi.**

and mahél “underwear” – **na "mahél úŋpi"**

and also “circle” – **nakúŋ "miméla"**

And here, circle has two m's! – **Na agná, miméla el "ma" núŋpa yukhé!**

“Clock” is also spelled with m. – **Naháŋ nakúŋ "ma" uŋ**

"mázaškaŋškaŋ" owápi.

Hey! Look at the clock! Gotta go...later! – **Wáŋ! Mázaškaŋškaŋ kiŋ waŋyáŋka yo!**

Iblámniŋ kte héčha...tókša!

m – **"ma"**

M is such a cool letter. – **"ma" kiŋ lé oówa khilí héčha yeló/kštó.**
