

Oówa kiŋ hé khilí yeló - Ĥ

Today, we are going to learn the letter Ĥ. – Anpétu kiŋ lé, "ĥe" unspéunkič'ičhiyapi kte.

Ĥ – “ĥe”

Ĥ makes a *ĥĥĥĥ* sound – “ĥe” léčhel eyápi: *ĥĥĥĥ*

Can you say Ĥ? – “ĥe” ehá oyákihi he?

Ĥ – “*ĥĥĥĥ*”

Ĥ is the first letter in the word “gray” – “ĥe” un “ĥóta” unkwówapi unkwókihipi.

And “a bell” – Naiŋš “ĥláhla”

Also “mountain” – Na nakúŋ “ĥe”

“Yesterday” I went hiking with my cousin up a mountain. – “Ĥtálehaŋ” thaŋkáši kičhí ĥé waŋ awáli.

It had rained so the trail was “muddy”. – Aléčhala mağážu čha očháŋkula kiŋ áta “ĥliĥlila.”

We hiked up all day. – Anpétu kiŋ átaya unkáli-haŋpi.

We didn't get back until the “evening”. – Na “ĥtayétu” háŋl unglíyoĥpayapi.

I really enjoy hiking with my cousin. – Haŋkáši kičhí imáğağaya omáwani čhaŋ iyómakphi.

But all that hiking made me really “sleepy!” – Éyaš akhé áta stustémič'iya čha waná “ĥwá” amahi!

Time for bed! – Waná ištíŋmapi iyémičihaŋtu weló!
