

Oówa kiŋ Hé Khilí Yeló! - K'

Today, we are going to learn the letter K'. – **Anpétu kiŋ lé, “k'o” unspéunkič'ičhiyapi kte.**

K' – “k'o”

K' makes a _____ sound – “k'o” léchel eyápi: **k'o**

Can you say K'? – “k'o” ehá oyákihi he?

K' – “k'o”

There are no people, places, or things that start with K'. – “k'o” un wičhóiyé čónala owápi, **iyótanš wóčaže líla čónala.**

Many words that start with the letter K' are action words. – **Wičhóiyé óta hčičiŋ “k'o” un owápi kiŋ hená wóškaŋ héčha.**

Like “to dig” a hole. – **K'á eyápi kiŋ hé él, “k'o” waŋ yaŋké.**

Or to “carry a bag” on your back. – **Na k'íŋ eyápi kiŋ hé él.**

Also “to give” something to someone. – **Na nakúŋ k'ú.**

It's also the first letter in the word to describe someone “being stubborn”. – **Naíŋš tuwá tókhi wanáŋ'un šni na tuktél iglóničiŋ naiŋš nałlál úŋ háŋtaŋš, k'ánažiŋ eyápi okíhipi.**

Sometimes I can be stubborn. – **Watóhaŋl šna miyé kayéš k'ó k'ánawažiŋ.**

I'm stubborn about how awesome the letter K' is! (laugh) – **Oówa waŋ k'o eyápi kiŋ lé iyótanšwala, na tuwéni hetáŋhaŋ mayáhomni okíhi šni, čha héchel k'ánawažiŋ séče! (i át'a)**

K' – “k'o”

What a cool letter. – **Oówa kiŋ hé khilí yeló,**

K' – “k'o”
