There are 4 stages of life. – **Tópakiya uŋkíčaḡapi.**

Child, Young Adult, Adult, and Elder – **Wakǵányeža, Tǵéča, Tǵáŋkaka, Wakáŋ**

4 – Tópa

There are 4 limbs on the body. – **Oyáya kiŋ uŋtópapi.**

2 arms, and 2 legs – **Istó núŋpa na hú núŋpa**

4 – Tópa

There are 4 seasons. – **Makǵóuŋčaḡe kiŋ tópa.**

Winter, Spring, Summer, and Fall – **Waníyetu, Wétu, Blokétu, Ptaŋyétu**

4 – Tópa

There are 4 directions. – **Tǵatúye tópa yukǵé.**

West, North, East, and South – **Wiyóŋpeyata, Wazíyata, Wiyóhiyaŋpata, Itókaḡata**

4 – Tópa

There are 4 parts to a plant. – **Watǵóŋho kiŋ táku tópa ikǵówake.**

The seeds, the roots, the stem, and the leaves – **Su, hutkǵáŋ, hú, čaŋwápe**

4 – Tópa

We can see “4” all around us. – **Uŋkíŋaŋokšaŋ táku tóbtopa óta waŋúŋyaŋkapi uŋkókihipi!**

Can you count to 4? – **Tópa iyágleya wílawá oyákihi he?**

1, 2, 3, 4 – **Wáŋči, núŋpa, yámni, tópa**

4 fingers – **Napsú tópa**
