Today, we are going to learn the letter T. – Anpétu kiŋ lé, "tu" unspéunċi'ičhiyapi kte.

T – "tu"

T makes a _____ sound – "tu" léčhel eyápi: tu

Can you say T? – "tu" ehá oyákihi he?

T – "tu"

T is the first letter in the word "four" – "tu" uŋ "tópa" unċówapi unċókíhipi.

Also "spy" – Nahán "tuŋwéya"

We can find the letter "T" in the middle of words, too. – Hó éyaš wičhóiyé óta él, "tu" waŋží yaŋké.

Like, Father. – "Até" eyápi kiŋ hé él, "tu" waŋ yaŋké, čhokáta.

My father took me fishing in a "boat" once. – Watóhaŋl até wáta waŋ él hokhúwa amái.

It was a beautiful "spring" day. – Héhaŋ wétu na átaya oíyokíphi.

There were "many" fish in the water. – Mní él líla hoğán ótapi.

One splashed water on my "face." – Waŋží iyótanš ité él mní amákapsiče.

Oh! That's cold! – Wáŋ, áta! Hé šní yeló.
