

Nasúla Wóslolye - Takú uŋ Waáunblezapi kiŋ

Hi! I'm Brain the Robot! – **Háu! Mas'wíchaša hemácha na Nasúla emáčiŋyape ló.**
And I have some quick facts about the human senses. – **Na takúku uŋkítħaŋčhaŋpi kiŋ ečíŋyatanħaŋ očíčíŋyakapi wačíŋ.**

Most people have the basic five senses. – **Tuwé kiŋ iyúha kiníl táku záptaŋ uŋ waábležapi.**
Hearing. – **Núŋže uŋ šna wanáuŋħ'uŋpi.**
Sight. – **Ištá uŋ šna wawáŋuŋyaŋkapi.**
Smell. – **Pħasú uŋ šna waóuŋmnapi.**
Touch. – **Napé uŋ šna waéuŋpathaŋpi.**
And taste. – **Na í na čeží uŋ šna wol-uŋkíyuthapi.**

These senses send messages to the brain. – **Lená uŋ uŋkínasulapi kiŋ waáunkičiblézapi.**
Animals have these senses too, but can be stronger or weaker than humans. – **Wamákháškaŋ kiŋ íš-eyá hécha yukħáŋpi, na watóħaŋl šna uŋkítħawapi kiŋ sáŋm waš'ákapi naíŋš húŋħ sáŋm húŋkapišni.**
For instance, most animals have a stronger sense of smell compared to humans. – **Wóiwáŋyaŋke waŋží kiŋ hé, wamákháškaŋ óta ħčíŋ uŋkísaŋm waómnapi okíhipi.**
