Cacti can gather water and hold it in their stems. – **Uŋkčéla kiŋháŋ makhátanhan mni yusképiŋ na ožíič'iyiŋ na hú él aígluha.**

Spines on the cactus protect it from animals who want to eat the plant and get to the water inside.
– **Na óta hča pŋepŋé, héchel naič'iziŋ, ičhíŋ wamákháškaŋ óta oyúl waštélakapi naiš mni él úŋ kiŋ iyútanpi.**

Some cacti even grow flowers and fruits. – **Uŋkčéla waŋžigži wanáhča na waskúyeča aíčhaŋe.**
