Today, we are going to learn the letter K. – Anpétu kiŋ lé “ku” unspéuŋkič’íchiyapi kte.

K – “ku”

K makes a \_\_\_\_\_ sound – “ku” léchel eyápi: k

Can you say K? – “ku” ehá oyákíhi he?
