Today, we are going to learn the letter L. – Anpétu kiŋ lé, "la" unspéuŋkič'ičhiyapi kte.

L – "la"

L makes a _____ sound – "la" léčhel eyápi: lllla

Can you say L? – "la" ehá oyákíhi he?

L – "lllla"

L is the first letter in the word Lakota. – "la" uŋ **Lakhóta** unkwápi unkwókihipi.

And "throat" or "red" – Na **loté** naiŋš **lúta**.

Also "uncle" – Na nakúŋ **lekší**.

I like to visit with my uncle. – **Lekší** athílehaŋg ya-áwaštewalake.

Hey uncle, can you cook something? – **Lekší**, takúŋ! **lol'ímiyečič'aŋ** oyákíhi he?

I'm hungry! – **Líla lowáčhiŋ yeló!**

(cooking and clock noises)

Whoa, that was fast! – **Wáŋ, líla nilúzahe!**

L – "la"

What a cool letter. – **Oówa kiŋ hé khilí yeló.**
