

## Oówa kiŋ Hé Khilí Yeló! - Kǎ

Today, we are going to learn the letter Kǎ. – Anpétu kiŋ lé, “kǎ” unspéuŋkič'ičhiyapi kte.

Kǎ – “kǎ”

Kǎ makes a \_\_\_\_\_ sound – “kǎ” léchel eyápi: kǎkǎkǎ

Can you say Kǎ? – “kǎ” ehá oyákihi he?

Kǎ – “kǎ”

Kǎ is the first letter in the word “plum” – “kǎ” uŋ “kǎŋta” unkwówapi unkwókihipi.

And “vein” or “playing card” – Na “kǎŋ” naiŋš “kǎŋsú”

Also “male-to-male friend” – Na nakún “kǎlá”

My “male-to-male friend” and I like to run. – Kǎláwaya wan kičhí waiŋmnanke s'a.

Especially in our bare feet. – Eyášna sičhóla unkw'íŋyanŋkapi.

Sometimes we race each other. – Watóhanŋ šna unkw'íŋyanŋkapi.

He's very good and often “passes” me. – Kǎlá áta ínyanŋ wóphikiŋ na kǎmápǎe s'a.

We just have to make sure to stay in the grass. – Éyaš takómni pǎézi akán ečé unkw'íŋyanŋkapi.

Because the pavement is often “hot”. – Ičhíŋ čhanjú sápe kiŋ líla kǎáte!
