Ž makes a _____ sound – “že” léčhel eyápi: žžžžže

Ž is the first letter in the word “to whistle” – “že” uŋ “žó” uŋkówapi uŋkókihipi.

And “to be rich” – Na “žičá”

Also “drinking glass” – Na nakúŋ “žanžán”

Yesterday I had lunch with my little, “blonde-haired” cousin. – Ĥtálehaŋ, haŋkášiwaya waŋ lila “žizi” čha kičhí wawáte.
